What is the Nanomanufacturing Summer Academy?

The Nanomanufacturing Summer Academy is a 6-week summer research program sponsored by the National Science Foundation to provide undergraduate research experience in the area of nanomanufacturing.

What is the purpose of this program?

The purpose of this program is to prepare, motivate, and encourage students to pursue an advanced degree in the area of engineering. To help maximize each participant's experience, each student will be paired with a faculty mentor and graduate mentor.

What are the requirements to participate in the program?

Applicants must demonstrate the following:

- U.S. Citizen or permanent resident
- A cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Entering junior or senior year during the 2010-2011 academic year with an engineering major
- Interest and passion in the field of science/engineering

**Students from underrepresented populations are strongly encouraged to apply.

When does the program take place?

The program begins on Monday, June 21, 2010 and ends Friday, July 30, 2010.

3. College transcript
4. Provide at least one reference's contact info.
